



COMPLIMENT ALPHABET

Here a great vocabulary lesson that you can maintain throughout the school year, adding as necessary. It makes a great poster or word wall, too! Have fun with it!



Steps:

Brainstorm compliments for each letter of the alphabet. (A is for Awesome, B is for bright or bubbly, C is for confident, d is for daring, etc.). Challenge students to focus on compliments that are for something other than the physical. Not “pretty” or “beautiful”.

Throughout the year, add more words to the list as students come up with more, and allow them to fill in with physical compliments as well. A can also be for “adorable” for example. The words can be used on spelling lists, story challenges, or any other vocabulary exercises.

A is for awesome, amazing, adorable
B is for bright, bubbly
C is for confident, caring, capable
D is for daring, darling, diligent
E is for excellent, exciting, empathetic
F is for fun, free, fresh
G is for good, great, gentle
H is for hopeful, helpful, humble
I is for intelligent, impressive, insightful
J is for just, jazzy, jubilant
K is for kind, kingly, knowledgeable
L is for loving, lovely, leader
M is for magnificent, magical, mysterious
N is for nice, noble, natural
