

ROLE PLAY

Role play has been proven to help students learn and effectively teach them how to handle difficult situations. And it's a lot of fun! Have kids acts out as many different scenarios as you can think of!



Steps:

Come up with scenarios to have the kids act out in front of their classmates. Then talk to the class:

- Were they being kind?
- What could the characters have done better?
- What did the characters do well?

Then ask the performers:

- How did they feel playing that part?
- How did they feel listening to the class talking about their character? Have them perform again, this time with any necessary kindness upgrades.

Suggested role plays:

- Wanting something someone else has and taking it without asking.
- Tattling
- Not listening to what the other person is really saying
- Bullying (3 people)
- Excluding someone (3 people)
